Intro: Ask students about where they are from. What do they know about their country?	10 min		
<ul> <li>Put students in pairs and have the pairs choose one of the following countries from the board:</li> <li><i>Beginner:</i> Ireland, Ukraine, Peru, Bengladesh, Indonesia, Nigeria, Sudan, Colombia, France, Mali</li> <li><i>Intermediate:</i> Czech Republic, United Kingdom, Switzerland, Kuwait, Tanzania, Norway, Greenland, Jamaica, Scotland, The Gambia</li> <li><i>Advanced:</i> South Africa, South Korea, Greece, Chile, Seychelles, Guyana, Macedonia, Puerto Rico, Namibia, Bosnia and Herzegovina</li> </ul>	5 min		
Main: Have students draw the flag of their respective country in Make Art. The students should also collect some facts about the country - population, currency, location, language. Teacher to offer support where needed.	35 min		
Learners to present their chosen country and coded flag to class.	15 min		
Learners to say 3 things they have learned this lesson about another country.	5 min
